LARGE PROJECT: Belden - Water System:

At the May monthly FRCCSD board meeting, the board unanimously voted to cancel the Belden Water System Damages FEMA projects worksheet #00043

FEMA/CalOES is processing the cancelation. FRCCSD can expect to hear sometime in the next 90 days.

SMALL PROJECTS: I have emailed and made numerous calls and spoken to a selection of CalOES employees trying to close out these projects. All FRCCSD small projects have been completed within the timelines allowed by FEMA. We turned in our P4 paper a year ago and it was ok'ed as complete by CalOES and sent to FEMA. Scott Wagner of CalOES is our liaison and is in the process of following up with FEMA.
